How Parents Can Help Their Students Succeed

Thank you to all the parents who attended Parent Teacher Conferences. By taking time out of your busy day to meet with your child's teachers, you have shown your child the importance of school, and your commitment to helping him or her succeed. Studies have shown that communicating regularly with teachers helps children succeed, and is among one of many factors that parents can do to help their students.

According to the U.S. Department of Education, in addition to brains and books, the parent plays a large role in ensuring a child's academic success. This means helping your child perform at his or her best, both physically and mentally. By emphasizing healthy choices and good study habits, you can help your child succeed in school.

Caring for your child's physical needs is an important aspect of student success. This means making sure your child gets plenty of rest each night and eats healthy snacks and meals. A healthy lifestyle will provide the energy needed to perform. Plenty of whole grains, protein, fruits and vegetables will give your child a good start, according to the U.S. Department of Education.

Establish a comfortable place where your child can sit and study. Minimize distractions, such as the television or loud music. Check on your child regularly to ensure assistance is not needed. While concentration is important, encourage short breaks if studying exceeds 45 minutes or an hour.

You can teach your child to be a good student by fostering a love of reading and making learning fun. If your child is younger, curl up in a comfortable chair and read some favorite books together. As your child gets older and reads independently, ask questions about what is being read, show interest, and engage in dialogue.

Healthy habits can be established early and adapted to fit the individual child. InshaAllah, the parents, the teachers, and the students can work together to help each one of our children succeed in this duniya and in the akhira.
